SPECIFICATION, SCOPE OF WORK AND MAP

- A) Project title: Project to Support for improving corn cultivation in the Mukumbi Group
- B) Brief project description: This project consists of supporting the offices of the consortium and the localities with 95 manual earth brick presses to improve their homes. And establish brickmakers' structures to achieve the project objectives and expected results. These, in turn, can organize themselves in cooperatives to sustain activities in the coming days and contribute to the reduction of juvenile and senile delinquency.
- C) Beneficiaries: The beneficiaries of this project are young people from seven villages namely: Mukumbi, Sandra, Kasansama, Kakonde, Kawama, Lumba-Kinsense, Makungu.

D) Objective of Project

- Contribute to the improvement of basic infrastructure, including housing in the country;
- ✓ Support young people to organize themselves into production units (cooperatives) in the manufacture of bricks to be sold to the various entrepreneurs who will carry out infrastructure construction projects (offices, schools, health centers, markets, etc.;
- Create a noble and profitable occupation for young people who are generally idle and left to the valuers.
- E) Project Results: The project will contribute to improving infrastructure in the villages of the region, which will have benefited from 95 manual brick presses. But also 19 brickmakers' cooperatives will be set up and will enable them to take charge of their households after the sale of the bricks. Many young people will have a noble occupation that will diminish idleness.

F) Implementation strategy

In view of the relevance of the project for young people, but also for all the communities affected during the execution of the project, it will be necessary to seek a local supplier, in compliance with the tendering procedure. For the mobilization and identification of young people or persons able to participate in the project, cooperatives will be set up for good management.



The brick-presses will be the assets of the cooperatives and not of the individuals who constitute them, any individual who withdraws from the cooperative of which he is a member may under no circumstances claim a brick-press.
